Felix Borowski (1872–1956) was born in the north-west of England, studied in London and Cologne, and taught the violin in Aberdeen, before emigrating to the USA in 1897. He spent the rest of his life in Chicago, teaching at the Chicago Musical College and Northwestern University, becoming the city's leading music critic, and also composing works including symphonies, ballets and an opera. His *Adoration* for violin and piano, published in 1898, is described in an American music dictionary of the 1930s as having 'achieved signal success and wide use'.
